Vision

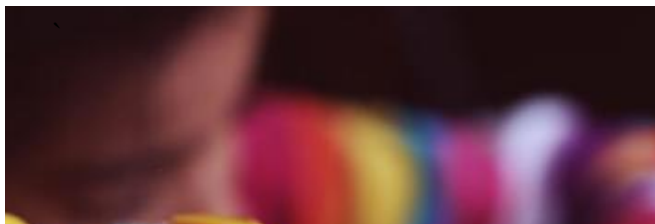

The **Master of Public Health** 2-year Degree Program has a total of 80 units.

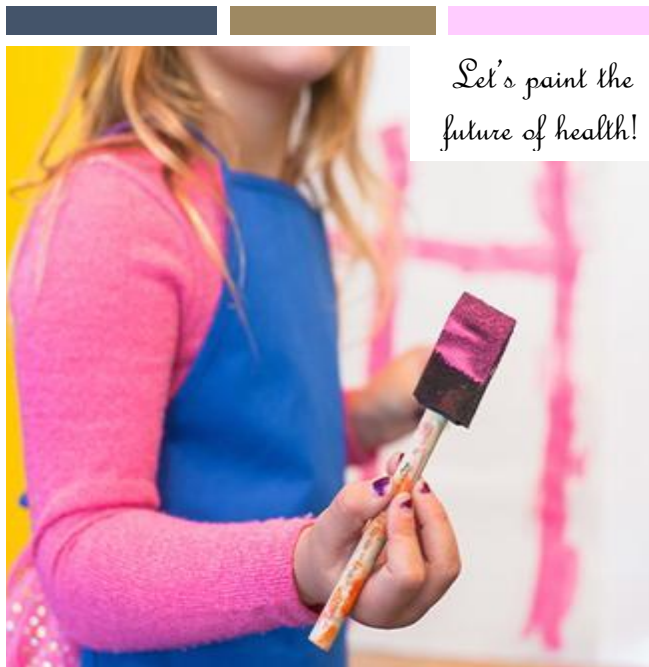

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant should be a graduate of an accredited school of medicine or other health sciences like nursing, physical therapy, dentistry, veterinary medicine, etc. or at least a baccalaureate degree in science, or other courses upon the evaluation and approval of the Admissions Committee.
2. At least 1 year experience in a public health institution or organization or any related field (which can be waived upon the recommendation of the Admissions Committee depending on its evaluation of the applicant's credentials)
3. Accomplished Application Form
4. Transcript of Records (Certified True Copy)
5. Certificate of Graduation from any recognized institution of higher learning (Certified True Copy)
6. NSO/PSA Birth Certificate
7. ID pictures 2"x2" (3 pcs) with white background
8. Payment of Application Fee
